The Bible says in Isaiah 64:7, "And there is none that calleth upon thy name, that stirreth up himself to take hold of thee: for thou hast hid thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities,"

Thank you for praying for us and lifting up the work of Moldova. We have seen the hand of God work through prayer countless time since we have been home on furlough. The Lord has allowed us to travel over 47,000 miles since January 2Nd, preaching and presenting the work of Moldova. We have seen 27 souls saved in our meetings. In the 8 months we have been traveling, God has blessed us beyond human comprehension. It has truly been a time of revival in our hearts for the things God has called us to do.

The work of Moldova continues to go on in our absence, but we are anxious to get back to our people and place. Clayton reports that two men were saved on the street while they were out disturbing tracts. The construction on the building is finally coming along and should be ready for the start of this year's Bible Institute class. The school 36 church is now meeting in the new building for services. Since we have moved our office and our church we have lost two Sunday school class areas. It is difficult for the children to get across town to the new building. The Lord laid on my heart to start praying again for vans to bus the children across town. Please pray as we restructure the Sunday school classes.

The Lord's Provisions and Answered Prayers

It has been exciting to watch the Lord answered prayer for the new building. Clayton called to tell us that the insulation for the outside of the building would cost \$12,000. It seemed like this was an impossible figure to come up with, but they were only requiring \$3,000 down to start work. After praying we decided to step out in faith and start the work not having any idea where the additional \$9,000 would come from. One week later I received a call from a church in Luana, Iowa that said they were going to support us with \$200 a month and they would be giving us 5 years in advance. The total of the check we received was \$12,000. **Praise the Lord!!!!** And that is exactly what we have been doing. Thank you Berean Baptist Church!

The Lord was not finished yet with the miracles He was doing on the building. The printing press that we were given was wired for 3 phase electric power. As it turns out, 10 years ago the owner of the house had 3 phase electric power put into the house, which is **extremely rare** in Moldova. It was amazing for us to see that the Lord has prepared this building for us 10 years ago as we were just starting work in this field. What an amazing God we serve!

As I write this letter, the printing press is being refurbished in Pennsylvania by Criswell Bible Baptist Church, so it will be in good working order upon arrival in Moldova. Many supplies have been donated to add to the print shop, we are still in need of a cutter. We are praying to have enough supplies to keep the print shop running for a year. The Lord graciously provided a brother that has worked on this type of press for 30 years, to come over to Moldova and teach us how to use it.

The Lord's blessing just keep pouring out on us. Now that we have the print shop, we needed a 40 foot container to ship it in. The Lord not only provided the money to buy the container and the cost of shipping it, but to also provided the custom taxes to get the container into the county. There is only one obstacle left and that is getting the container into a communistic country. "With men it is impossible. But not with God, for with God all things are possible." We have no doubt in the fact that God will get His print shop into the country to the building He prepared 10 years earlier. Please join us in prayer that the process will be a speedy one.

(Over Please)

Since the Lord provided the container for the printing press we have an unusual opportunity to ship things we would not have had otherwise. Anchor of Hope Orphan Foundation will be doing a book bag project for the orphans and less fortunate children in Moldova. We are shooting the 10,000 book bags to be shipped on the container. If you are interested, we have enclosed information on this project.

In all the excitement over the new building, we neglected the fact that we have no furniture to fill the Sunday school room and Bible Institute Class rooms. We are in need of small tables and chairs for S.S. rooms, we need tables and chairs for the teen classes and institute class rooms, and we need some kind of seating for the sanctuary. If your church has any of these supplies that you are no longer in need of and would like to sell or donate them, we could put them on the container to ship them. Please contact me at 330-309-2525 to make arrangements.

Thanks to Old Path Bible Baptist Church we have been given \$10,000 to work on the first orphan house of God's Orchard. We have talked to several people across the country about being house parents for the first group of children. It will take until next year to finish the construction and get it ready for occupancy. Please pray that God would raise up the family He wants to work in God's Orchard.

I will be returning to the field August 23rd. We will be having the second annual Bible Baseball Camp starting Monday August 27th, with former major leaguer Wade Rowdon, Major Henry Parrish of the US Marine Corp and Christ Jones. We will be holding the camp near the new building trying to reach children to build up our new Sunday school. Please pray for the success of the camp, that many children will attend and that souls will be saved. At the end of the camp we will have an award ceremony at our church and invite the parents. Last year we had 180 in attendance. This is a great opportunity to witness to these families. Pray that hearts will be open and receptive to the Gospel.

As we start our third term on the field, we will only have Blake, our youngest son, with us. Brittney, Blaine and Blair will be attending college in America. Two young ladies, Joanna Flowers and Jessica Midcap, from one of our supporting churches will accompany Susan and Blake on September 6th. Please pray for these young ladies as they will be working in the orphanages several days a week for 6 weeks.
