and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.” II Corinthians 9:6*

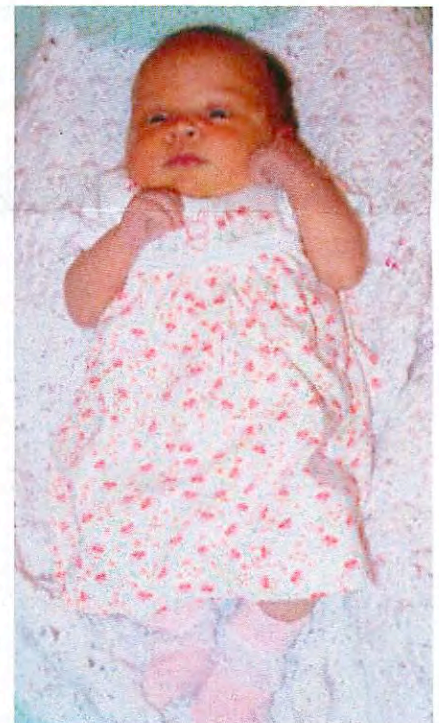
Dear Pastor, Praying Friends, and Family,

The principle found here in the Bible is that the more that we sow the Word of God, the more fruit we will reap. We may not always see the fruit immediately after sowing, but if we are patient, that seed will bring forth its fruit in its season. We continue to sow the seed of the Word of God here in Chisinau. This last month we were privileged to see some fruit of our labors and we have great confidence that we will see even more fruit in the future.

While passing out tracts one Tuesday afternoon, a man took a tract and started to ask questions about it. This man, Dima, asked what he should do in order to understand the Bible better. I explained to him that the first step to greater understanding of the Bible is that he needed to be born again by the Spirit of God. I explained the Gospel to him but it was difficult for him to understand that salvation is the gift of God, not of works because he came from a religious background that taught that you must earn salvation. After forty-five minutes of reasoning together and studying the Scriptures, Dima bowed his head there on the street and received Christ as his personal Saviour! Please pray that he will come to church and grow in his walk with God. He seemed genuinely interested in attending church and learning more.

Last winter, I met a fellow named Igor on the streets while passing out tracts. He was curious about the Gospel tracts and the Bible but he wasn't ready to trust Christ right then, though we did share the Gospel with him. A few weeks ago he called me at home around 11:00 PM on a Saturday night. He had lost his job, his wife left him and he was feeling very down. He asked me what he should do. I told him that he needed to get right with God and get saved. About thirty minutes later, he prayed with me over the phone and trusted Christ as Saviour!!! He lives in a village outside of Chisinau. Pray that we would be able to maintain contact with Igor and that he would also grow in Christ.

It has been very exciting to welcome these two new births into the family of God. We are also excited to welcome a new addition to our family! Kayla Grace McCurdy was born July 8, 2007, at 12:25 PM. She weighed 2.75 kg (6 lbs. 1 oz.) and was 51 cm long (20 in.). The birth went smoothly, and both mom and baby are healthy and doing well. We thank you for your many prayers and we thank God for His answers and faithful provision.
