The cost ranged from \$8,000-\$11,000, not including the extra fees that may pop up at different points. The value of the things that would be in the container would not cost as much as the container itself. We were already planning to purchase furniture and appliances when we get down there. I have attached pictures of some of the items we will need to purchase.

In July we were in meetings in Texas and Oklahoma. We were blessed with the opportunity to meet some sweet missionaries and sweet church families. In August we headed back to our home church to go through the remainder of our stuff. We had another yard sale and were able to sell almost everything. The rest will be donated. We will be keeping some sentimental items in storage. It was good to see our church family again, see how the church has grown, and how the Lord has moved in the lives of the people there.

While in Missouri we were able to present at a church and schedule some meetings, filling in dates that we had available. Our oldest son, Seth, was able to attend the Teen Conference at our church. This was a milestone for him! He was so happy to be there for it. It was good to see our oldest daughter, Elizabeth, and her husband. We had not had the chance to see them since the wedding at the end of March. We left out on the road a couple of days after the wedding, and hadn't been back since. It makes us feel so old to have a child that is married! Now on to the next one!

Please pray for Pastor Carlos Cifuentes, the national pastor we will be working with when we start out. He injured his knee (torn ACL and torn Meniscus) while I was in Chile and will be having surgery on September 21st. Pray that surgery goes well and that he heals up quickly.
